As many of you may know, the County of Amador is preparing a comprehensive update of the County's General Plan, setting forth the goals, policies, and objectives for land use and project development decisions for the next 20+ years.

To date, the General Plan Update process has been comprised of gathering information, data, and comments through various Open Houses, Workshops and General Plan Advisory Committee (GPAC) meetings. Three alternative land use maps representing a spectrum of potential land use development scenarios were developed. These 3 alternatives (Alternatives A, B, and C) were reviewed by the GPAC and the public. Comments were received on the various components of these alternatives and from those comments a fourth alternative, Alternative D, was developed. The Planning Department is now seeking comment on this alternative and the components of the proposed land use classifications, goals and policies. These comments will be incorporated into the information being developed by staff for presentation at the upcoming Joint Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors' meeting scheduled to be held over 3 days (October 14, 15, and 16 – a notice with more information will be forthcoming).

Information and background on the general plan process will also be provided, as well as an opportunity to review all proposed Land Use Maps (Alternatives A, B, C and D). To review pertinent material regarding these four Alternative Land Use Maps, the proposed Land Use Classification Workbook, and the Preliminary Land Use Goals and Policies Workbook, please visit our website at www.co.amador.ca.us/dept./planning or contact the Planning Department if you would like to request hard copies of this material (20¢ per page charge for copies).

All property owners and interested parties are encouraged to attend this workshop to provide input regarding the general plan update.
